### **Background Previous Conferences**

Earlier this year, the National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT) provided support through Mahidol University to the National Economic and Social Development Council (NESDC) to hold a series of virtual national conferences on enhancing coordination and achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in Thailand. This conference will be the third in this three-part series.

### **Previous Conferences**

The first two national conferences were held for three hours each on 27 May and 2 June 2021 under the title "Thailand and the Sustainable Development Goals: Learning and Boosting Implementation Together". They were attended by 250 participants from 35 countries spanning the public, private, academic, research and nongovernmental sectors. NRCT, the United Nations Resident Coordinator Office (UN Thailand) and the UN Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP), in collaboration with NESDC, Mahidol University, the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) and the Digital Belt and Road (DBAR) program collaborated in designing and delivering the conferences.

The conferences' five aims included:

- Raise awareness of Thai stakeholders ٦. about the 2030 Agenda and its Goals, especially concerning follow-up and review mechanisms.
- 2. Review the state of Thailand's implementation of the Goals.
- 3. Identify Thailand's priority Goals, current data gaps and potential approaches for follow-up and strengthening review, including proxy indicators and data sources.
- 4. Identify priority research areas.
- 5. Capture lessons learned from Thailand that can be shared regionally and globally.

Based on participant feedback as well as feedback from NESDC, the conferences successfully met their objectives. A summary of the conference proceedings can be found on the NESDC website.
